Camp Check in & Out

Camps begin and end their day at Dovercourt Recreation Centre. Please drop off your camper between 8:45 & 9:00am at their camp sign. Camp check out will take place between 4:00 & 4:15pm. Ski Camp drop off & pick up is at JA Dulude Arena.

Daily Attendance

If your child will be late for camp or will not be attending for the day, please phone our camp attendance number at 613.798.8950 ext. 306 before 9 am.

Pre & Post Camp

Need to send your kids to camp but work early or late? We provide before and after camp care. Pre Camp: 7:30-8:45am; Post Camp: 4:15-6pm. Fees include both pre and post camp.

Our Facilities

Camps for ages 4 years are held at Dovercourt Recreation Centre (DRC). Camps for ages 5 and older make use of DRC and offsite locations within walking distance of the Community Centre. Camp drop off and pick up is always at Dovercourt Recreation Centre.

Medications

Special Needs

First time Campers

For first time campers, we recommend you visit the facility before camp begins. Join us for an open or family swim. Stop by and play on the play structure or "hang out" in the upstairs lobby. This will help you and your child become familiar with our Centre. Don't forget that you can call and speak to our managers or coordinators about camp and any specific questions or concerns.

Swimming

Swimming takes place at Dovercourt's Indoor Pool and other supervised facilities. We do not provide lifejackets/PFDs but you are welcome to supply your own. Counsellors participate in the pool with their camps and lifeguards are on duty at all times.

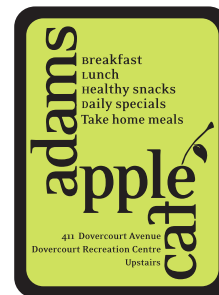

Online registration is available through our e-connect site, accessible from the top of every page of our website at www.dovercourt.org. 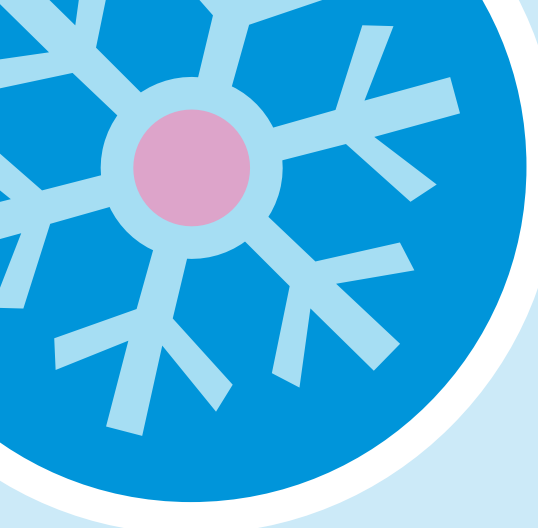
