

Job Posting: Inclusion Support Staff Summer Camp Inclusion Staff

The role of the Inclusion Support Staff is to work with the team of Camp Directors and Counselors to ensure a high-quality camp experience for campers with special needs. Inclusion staff will report to the Inclusion Coordinator to promote the physical, emotional and social health through integration of all children requiring a 1:1 ratio support. **This position is an hourly paid position at a rate of \$16.55-\$22.00 per hour and qualifications include:**

- Complete or in-progress post-secondary degree or diploma in development social work, behavioral science, psychology, child and youth work, or related field of study an asset.
- Proven experience working with campers with special needs in a camp/school setting.
- Standard First Aid & CPR C (course taken no earlier than September 2022)
- Police Record Check, for service with the vulnerable sector
- Training in Behavioural Management an asset

Before continuing with the application process, please make note of the following:

1. All Inclusion Staff are asked to commit to the full summer of $\underline{9}$ weeks of work from July 2^{nd} to August 30^{th} .

Weeks or days off may be given as agreed upon with the Inclusion Coordinator.
